- Conduct yourself in an appropriate manner during training and matches.
- Respect the club and its property.

Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct

We encourage parental/guardian support and welcome everyone to attend training sessions and matches, however we ask that the juniors can learn play and enjoy cricket at all times.

All parents and guardians are expected to uphold parental club rules, which are:

- Encourage and Support your child to learn and play within the rules.
- Help your child to recognise good performance and effort not just the result.
